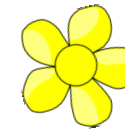

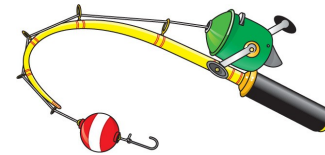


THE GREAT OUTDOORS

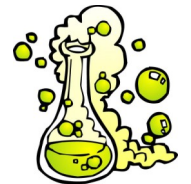


KITCHEN CHEMISTRY
